CPR is an emergency lifesaving procedure performed when the heart stops beating. Performing immediate CPR and using a defibrillator can double or triple the chances of survival after cardiac arrest. A sudden cardiac arrest is when an irregular heart rhythm causes a loss of the heart's activity.
